Traverse City.

WHAT: Lane shifts with flag control.

WHERE: Shoulders along the following roads in Garfield and East Bay Townships:
 *Hammond Road, Three Mile Road to Garfield Road
 *Garfield Road, Hammond Road to Three Mile Road
 *Three Mile Road, Garfield Road to South Airport Road.

WHEN: Tuesday, June 16, 2015

WHY: Crews will be cutting back the high ridges of excess material along the shoulders of the above-listed roads. Material will be loaded in trailers for disposal off-site.

IMPACT TO TRAFFIC: A portion of the travel lane closest to the shoulder will be used for this moving operation along the road sections.

On multi-lane sections, traffic will be shifted.

On single-lane sections, traffic will be impacted only in the work area where operations are being performed.

Traffic will be directed by flagging operations and experience delays as crews perform this on-going project.

Traffic fines are doubled in work areas. Motorists are asked to slow down and give our road workers a brake!
